To this day, Flekkefjord oak and huge amounts of granite that supports the city of Amsterdam. The dutch people have also put their mark on Flekkefjord, which is also called dutch city.

The village Knaben in Kvinesdal is built around mining and is also known for its mining of molybden. Molybden was important for the armor industri and the germans built huge fortresses around Knaben. In 1943 it was attacked twice by the allied forces. Come along on a guided tour in the mines and in the museum.
